

# ANNUAL ARCTIC 3-D SHOOT

## FEBRUARY 21, 2010



We are pleased to announce the Annual Arctic 3D shoot to be held Sunday **February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2010**. Registration will begin @ **7am**. All are welcome and **you do not have to be an archer** to participate. **Members and Guests are welcome!**

Breakfast is included and will be available from **7am to 10am** at the kitchen.

Cost will be \$10 per person and will cover entry fee (for those shooting), breakfast, game dinner, and one raffle ticket for the **Table Raffle**. The Table raffle will be an assortment of prizes. Additional tickets will be available, 1 ticket for \$5.00 and 3 tickets for \$10.00. There also will be a bow raffle, for a new Hoyt Compound (cost for this raffle is \$10.00 per ticket) with proceeds going to the John Penney Scholarship Fund after costs are covered. (\*\*Note: The bow Raffle will be open to **Members Only**)

A Game Dinner will follow shooting at the **Indoor Range from 1pm onward**. All are welcome to attend, shooters and non-shooters alike. We ask all that are planning to attend **please bring a Game dish**. If you do not have game **please bring a dessert**.

The course will consist of (20) 3D targets at various yardages. Only field points (practice tips, **NO BROADHEADS**) maybe used. All archery equipment is acceptable. If you do not have equipment, and wish to participate, please contact the Archery Chairman and Club Equipment can be provided. Scoring will be consistent with the Baystate Archers 3D (IBO scoring format) of 12, 10 or 8 points depending on where you hit within the kill zone, 5 points for hitting the target outside the kill zone and 0 points for a miss.

There will also be the Presentation of the Annual Big Game Award taken by Archery methods. To qualify for this award you **must be nominated**. Please send all nominations to Jon Carey ([jcarey@gcrtemps.com](mailto:jcarey@gcrtemps.com)) **by noon on Feb 12<sup>th</sup>** in order for the selection committee to have time to review all nominees. **Any late nominations will not be accepted.**
